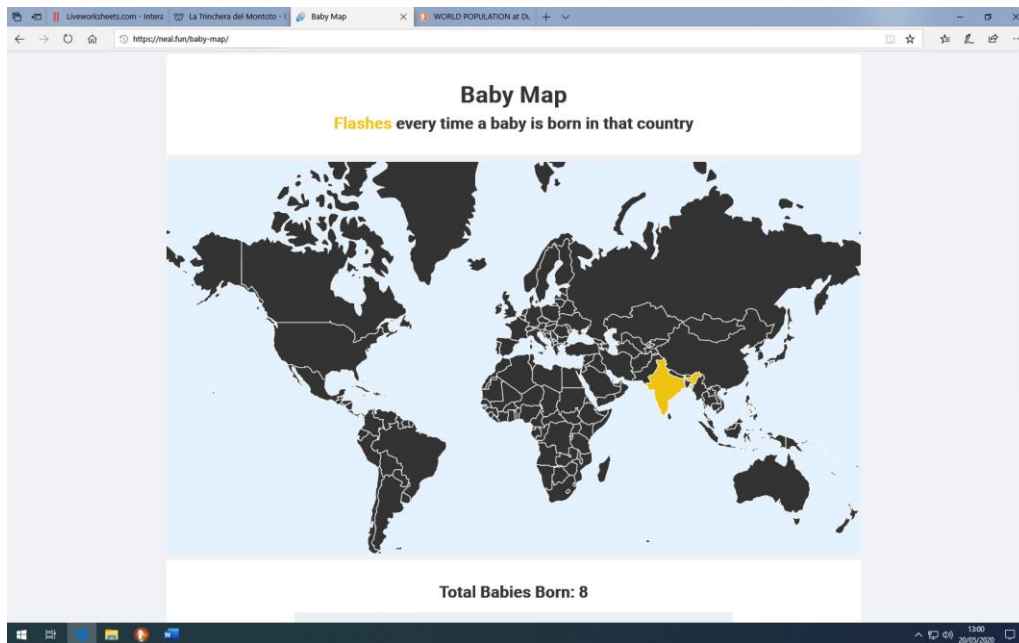


BABY MAP

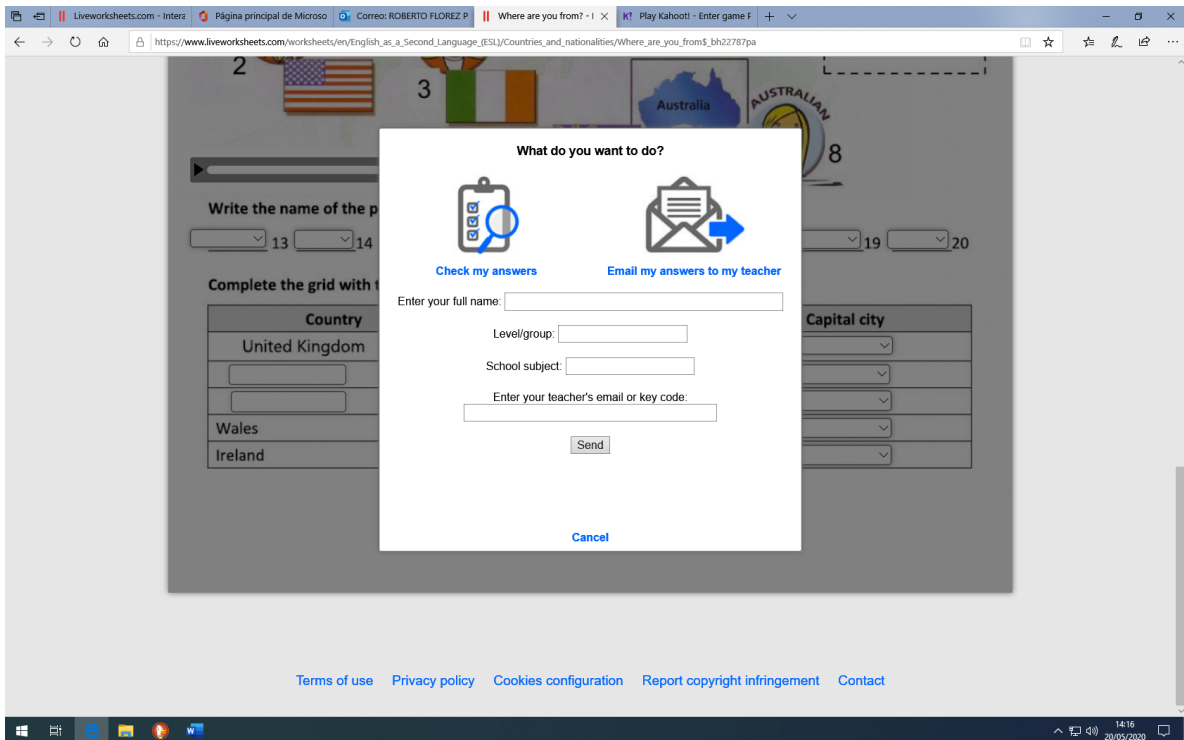
